

Information note on Regulation 15



Provision of information

If a local authority considers that a private water supply in its area is a potential danger to human health, it must take appropriate steps to ensure that people likely to consume water from it:

- a) are informed that the supply constitutes a potential danger to human health and the local authority must serve a Regulation 18 Notice;
- b) where possible, are informed of the nature of the potential danger; and
- c) are given advice to allow them to minimise any potential danger.
